

FREE CHARANGA TRAINING FOR MEMBER SCHOOLS

SoundStorm has pledged to provide all KS1 and KS2 member schools with a Charanga license for 2018/2019.

To launch this initiative all member schools are invited to attend a training session run by a Charanga representative to familiarise yourselves with the resource.

Charanga is the winner of the Music Teacher Awards for Excellence: *Best Digital/Technological Resource*. It encompasses a comprehensive wealth of resources ranging from week-by-week lessons for each year group (from Reception to Year 6), to a vast library of individual songs and courses. It is ideal for specialist and non-specialist teachers and provides lesson plans, assessment, clear progression, and engaging and exciting whiteboard resources for every lesson.

***Anyone Can Play** is a Scheme of Work conceived to empower the non-specialist music teacher to teach and support children with severe learning needs through their music making journey. Another function is CREATE, containing compositional projects using iPad technology to inspire, motivate and capture young people's creativity. In this session you will explore all the SEND elements and how they can be linked with the Charanga Musical School programme.*
