



MUSICAL STORYTELLING - COVID FRIENDLY

You do not need to sing!

Yes, initially the project was planned so the children could learn the songs, sing along as well as learning a range of musical skills through activities taught through percussion. However, you can just listen to the songs and work through the activities in the pack which are mostly instrumental based.

Instead of singing:

- Listen to the audio tracks and draw pictures about what they see
- Make up actions for the songs
- Hum along

Other ideas:

- Create puppets for the story then listen to the songs and retell using their puppets
- Put percussion instruments to each song to represent sounds in the story (children running down to the beach, finding starfish come in and out of the water, magical sounds as they travel down into the ocean etc.)
